WELCOME TO 5th GRADE!!!! This year is going to be amazing. I look forward to getting to know you and your students and working together to ensure they receive a quality education. This Disclosure Document will familiarize you with what is required of your child this year.

Absences and Tardies: Each day in 5th grade builds upon the day before. Daily attendance is expected as well as arriving promptly each morning. Instruction begins every day at 8:00 a.m. If the student arrives later than this they will be marked tardy. Major assignments, which will be noted as they are assigned, are expected to be turned in regardless of absences. Please make an effort to attend each day on time and to keep open communication with the teacher.

Positive Behavior Support System (PBSS): Students will be treated as capable people and will be expected to act responsibly and respectfully. Students will be expected to accomplish their work, contribute to the classroom environment and conduct themselves as responsible citizens. Students are encouraged to be HEROES!! I use a positive method in helping students behave appropriately. In my classroom I use a variety of incentives such as Call Bucks, tickets, kisses (chocolate of course), etc. Students receive small prizes for good behavior, good management of time, helping others, staying on task, successfully working together as a team, etc.

Grading: Mastery Connect

Homework: Students will be assigned homework periodically throughout the year. **Unfinished classwork does not count as part of the homework total, but is in addition to homework.** Homework assignments will be meaningful and focused on improving student's skills. Please encourage your students to turn it in on time and be responsible.

School Supplies (Donations): The supply list for my classroom is on the Lincoln Website.

Communication with the teacher: Open lines of communication are strongly encouraged. You will receive **DAILY EMAILS** concerning what is happening in our classroom. My website will also have very detailed information on what happens in the classroom as well as announcements, updates, assignments, homework, projects, instructions, etc. I update my website every weekend for the following week (www.mrscallsfifthgradeheroes.com). There will be two formal parent/teacher conferences during the year. Should you desire additional conferences, please know that I will be happy to meet with you.
